Minimum qualifications for candidates include a 3.5 grade point average; a class rank in the top 5 percent (provided your school ranks students); and minimum combined SAT-I of 1350, or ACT composite of at least 30. Just as importantly, we ask that you nominate well-rounded and creative students who exhibit outstanding leadership, participation in sports or physical fitness, skills in communication, and participation in co-curricular activities. J. Ollie Edmunds Scholars should possess outstanding character and personal integrity, high motivation and the potential to serve as role models to the Stetson community.

The deadline for receipt of this nomination (Part II) and the student's scholarship application (Part I) is January 22, 2010. An application for admission is required. *(Please print legibly.)*
